

# WinLink Tuesday

## When

This net will run each Tuesday (except 4th of July, Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Year's) for 24 hours. Check in anytime during the 24 hour period.

## Sending Messages

There are two ways to send messages:

- Use VARA HF WinLink through a gateway.
- Use Telnet.

Address messages to Lew KB5HPT DEC Dist. 6, WTX Section, and Jim NE8U, Radio Operator, Dist. 6, WTX Section unless otherwise noted.

Use Radio Operator for your position/title.

### *VARA HF*

- The HF station will be listening to 7116.5 MHz center frequency, 7115.0 MHz dial frequency.
- Jim NE8U will be listening on 7063.5 MHz center frequency, 7062.0 MHz dial frequency from 0800 to 1000 Mountain Time.
- Lew KB5HPT will be listening on 3595.0 MHz center frequency, 3593.5 MHz dial frequency 1800 to 1900 Mountain Time.
- All frequencies bandwidth is 500Hz.
- Make sure that the **Request Read Receipt** is checked at the top of the message.
- Mark the message as **WinLink Message**, **P2P WinLink**, or **Radio-Only**.
- To get credit for the net, all senders must receive a message acknowledgement back.
- RF is preferred over Telnet.
- If the new message update or WinLink Express program update screen appears when opening WinLink Express, update before beginning the exercise.
- When sending to multiple stations in P2P mode, notice that there will be multiple messages in the Outbox. Multiple sessions are needed to deliver them.

### *P2P Information*

In the **Open Session** box, select **VARA HF P2P**, then open the session. For the Mode, use **USB-D**.
